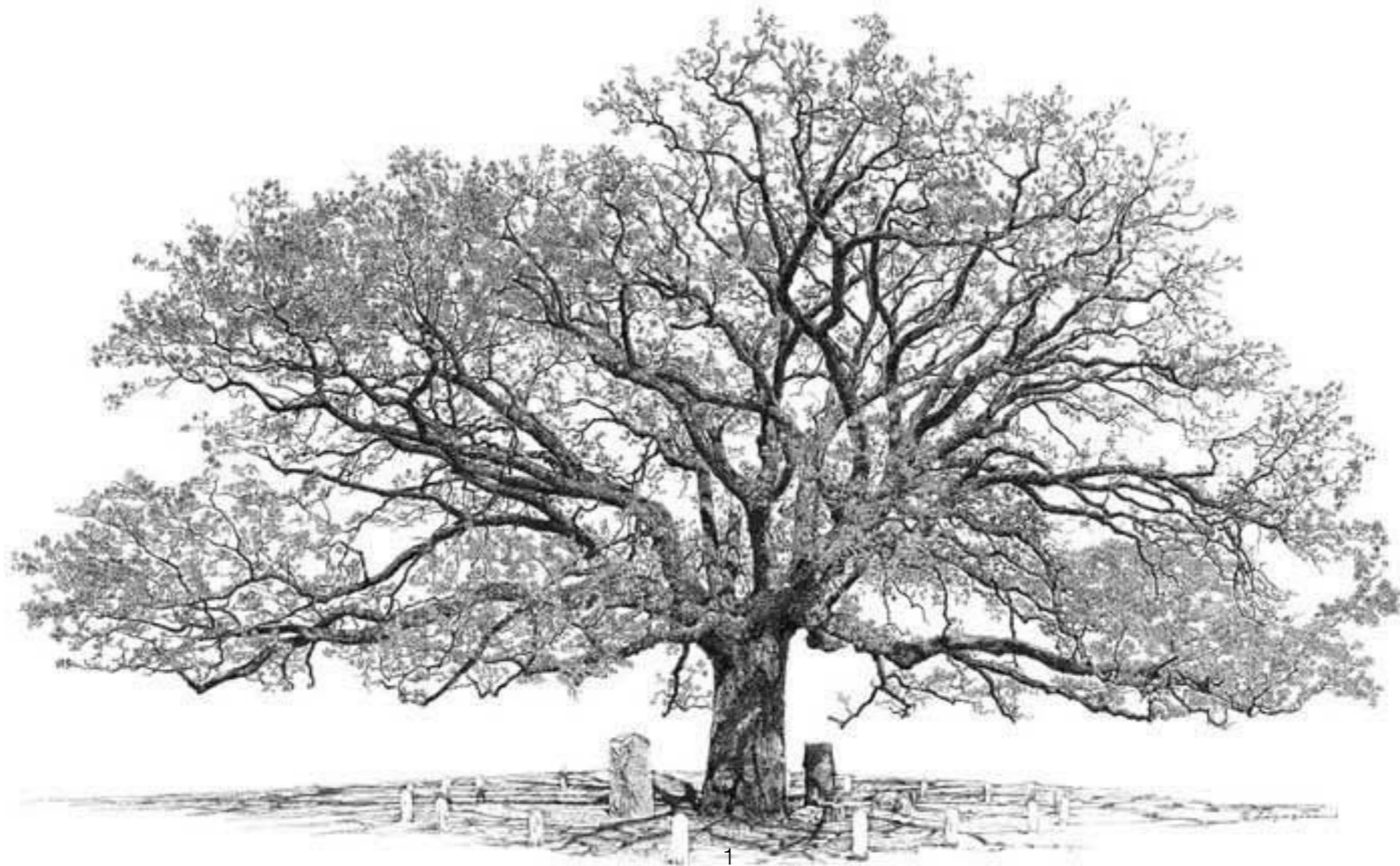

Pedigree Chart
