In Paint 3D, select **3D** from the top menu, select a 3D object from the right menu, then draw the shape in the workspace.



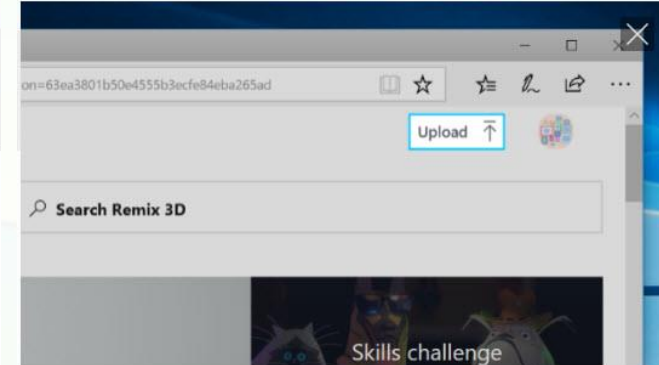
Turn a sketch into a 3D object

In Paint 3D, select **3D** from the top menu, select **3D doodle**, choose **Sharp edge** or **Soft edge**, and then draw a shape in your workspace. Connect the dots to create a 3D object.



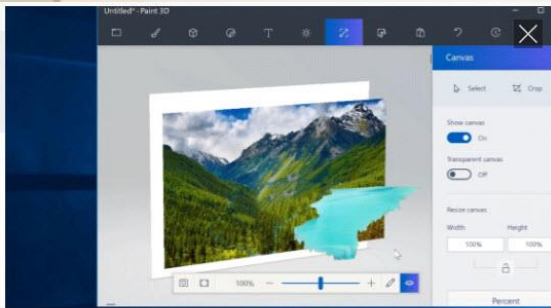

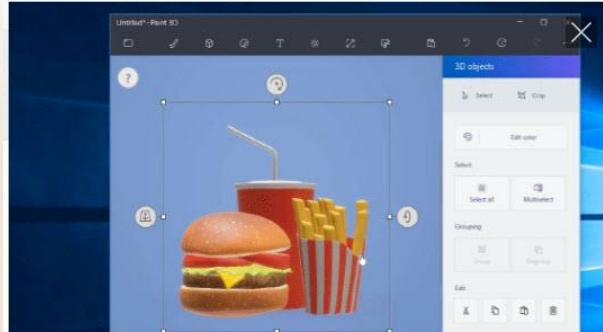

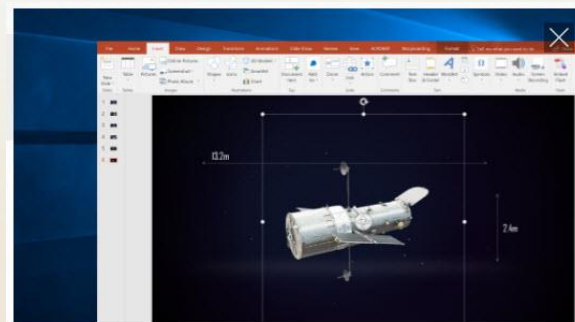
Cut out shapes from images

In Paint 3D, select **Remix 3D** from the top menu. Search for a specific model for your project, or browse the 3D content.

Open Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, or Outlook. Select **Insert > 3D Models > Online Sources**. Browse the 3D models, and then select one to insert it into your work.

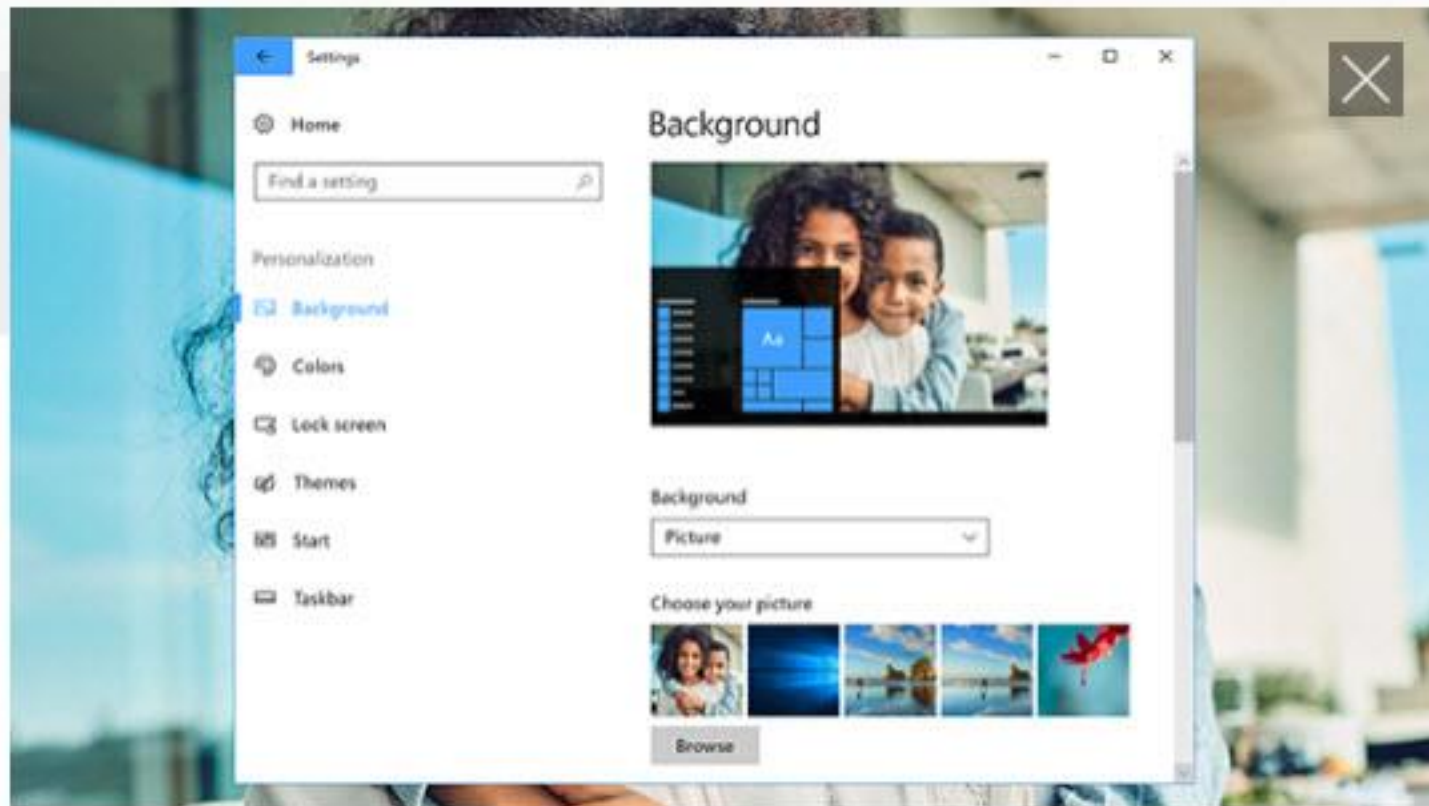
